simple past tense with core verbs: <i>came, gave, made, ran, said, saw, went</i> , etc Questions with <i>what, who, when, where, why</i> <i>there is/are/was/were</i>					
simple past tense with additional verbs, including <i>bought, fell, hid, slept</i> , etc going to (future) <i>will</i> (future) present continuous with future meaning <i>must/must not</i> <i>could/could not</i> questions with <i>how, how many/how much</i> time clauses with <i>after, before</i> and <i>when</i> comparison of adjectives with <i>-er</i> and <i>more</i>					
simple past tense with additional verbs, including <i>blew, forgot, rode, tied</i> , etc present perfect tense <i>have to/don't have to</i> <i>need to/don't need to</i> <i>see/watch/hear</i> + verb + ing first conditional simple relative clauses with <i>who, which, that</i> possessive pronouns comparisons with <i>as ... as</i>
