
- a Which places have you been to in Japan?

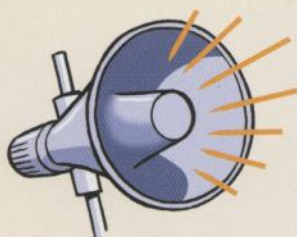
