

HOW IT WILL BE ASSESSED



Phase 1

Criterion-based Assessment:

- Spelling, punctuation, and layout
- Grammatical accuracy
- Vocabulary range
- Fluency and appropriacy of style
- Originality of thought and expression
- Word count
- Relevance to the topic
- Organization of the content

Phase 2

General Impression Assessment:

- Mention of title, author, story (genre), time and place, and setting of the story
- Description of the main characters
- Summary of the plot
- Personal evaluation of the story
- Evaluation of the Story's appeal for peers
- Graphic elements and colour scheme
- Layout and design
- Overall attractiveness
- Justification for artwork

Phase 3

Final total:

- The 'criterion-based' and 'general impression' subtotals will be combined to get a final total.

Any entries that fail to meet the criteria will be disqualified. In order to ensure the entries are evaluated, allow students to submit their original, age-appropriate, non-AI generated materials in the templates provided for each category.

All entries need to be submitted by the school authority.
