

## Glossary

- answering machine** (page 14) a machine which answers the telephone for you if you are not there

- arrest** (page 10) to take someone to the police station.

- arrivals** (pages 18, 19) the times when planes or trains arrive

- baggage** (pages 14, 18, 19) suitcases and other bags

- balcony** (page 8) a small platform on the outside of a building

- board** (page 15) (in this story) the place in an airport where people can read about flights

- castle** (page 9) a large, old building with strong walls and towers, ready for fighting against enemies

- copy** (page 20) something which looks exactly like something else

- delayed** (page 22) late, not on time

- departures** (page 15) the times when planes or trains should leave

- dizzy** (page 8) if your head goes round and round, you are dizzy

- dragon** (pages 2, 3, 7...) an unreal animal with wings which breathes out fire and smoke

- exit** (page 19) the way out

- flight** (pages 4, 14) a journey by aeroplane

- frightened** (page 16) very afraid

- gate** (page 24) a door made of wood or metal, often the way into a garden

- lounge** (page 19) a room with comfortable chairs for people to wait in

- message** (page 17) what you want to say to someone, but you can't tell them directly

- path** (page 29) a narrow road for people to walk along but too small for cars

- priest** (page 24) a man who spends his life working for God

- private** (page 8) closed to most people

- spring** (page 20) a place where water comes up from under the ground naturally

- temple** (page 24) a building where people think, pray and talk to God
